Directions:

- Floor Dust mop or sweep floor area.

-With Prepare solution in the following ratios: light build up: 32oz per gallon of water, medium build up: 48oz per gallon of water, heavy build up: 64oz per gallon of water.

-When using on asphalt tile, first test solution in an inconspicuous area.

-Apply liberally without flooding with mop or auto scrubber. Do not allow solution to dry. Apply more stripper solution if drying occurs too quickly. -Neutralize/rinse floors.

First Aid:
